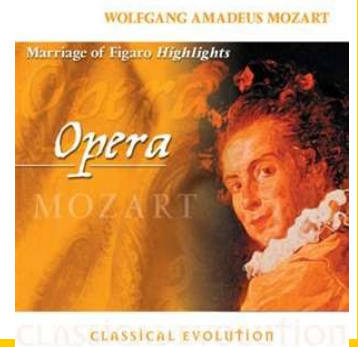
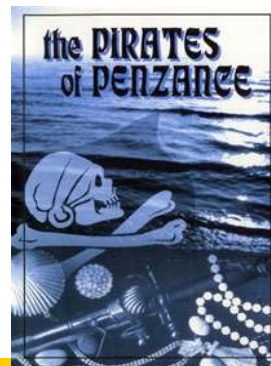
## Opera Workshop

The festival will feature the best international contemporary chamber music performed by NOISE and Delenda Est Carthago (both of which include Adler on piano), and the Formalist Quartet and guest artists Matthew Burtner (saxophone) and Robert Zeligman (clarinet). Composers from around the world will be in attendance, including USD's Nathan Brock. The festival also includes a community workshop in the performance of experimental music.
