Meetings

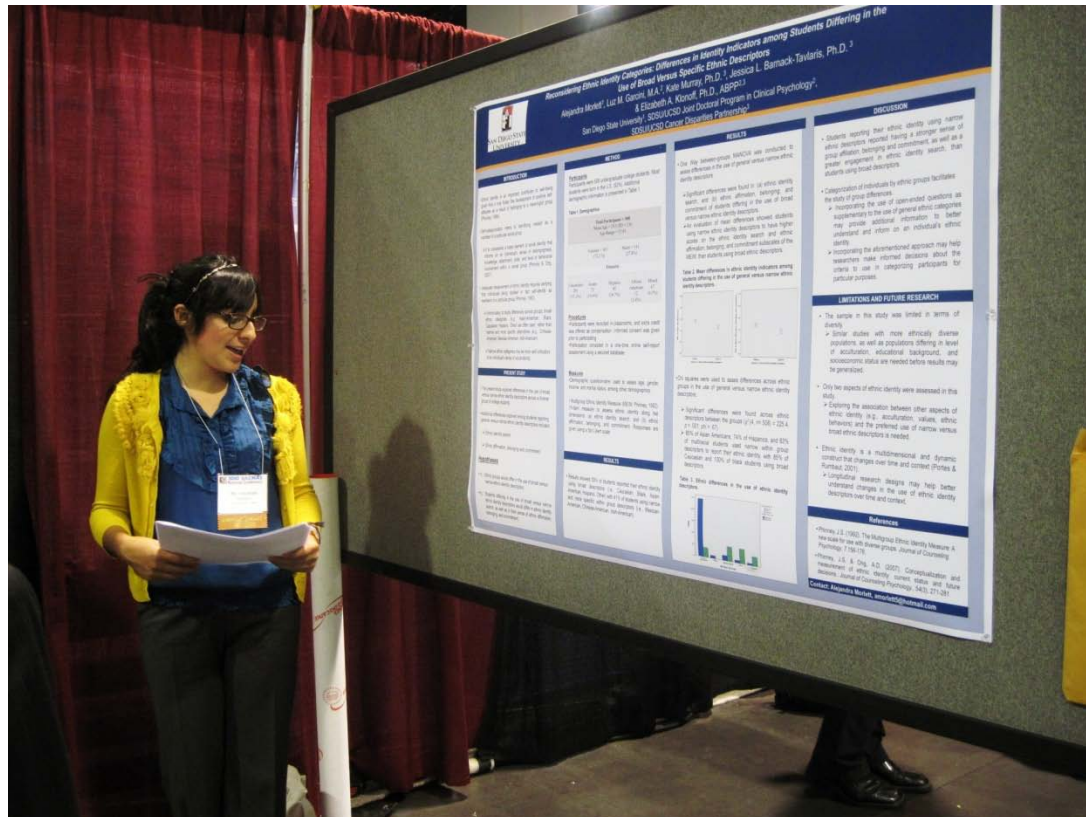
- Spring 2011
