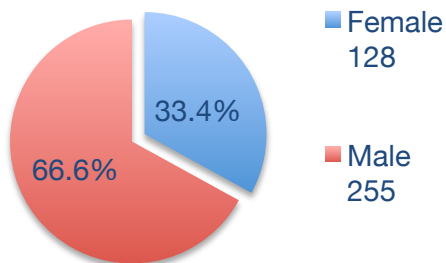

### Gender Distribution: Undergraduate Population

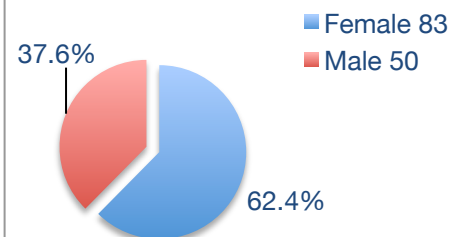
