Executive Summary: Fall 2011 Statistical Report

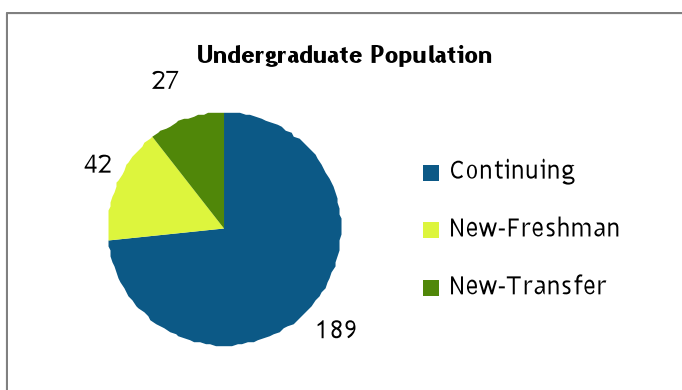

^{†††} J-1 are non-immigrant exchange visitors participating in programs that promote cultural exchange or business training within the U.S.



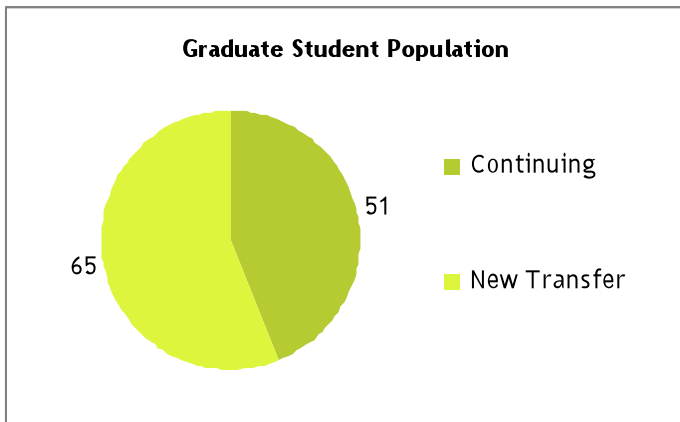
