MAPJ GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Full-time or part-time status as a graduate student
- Required Orientation
- Approval of courses by faculty advisor
- 39 units of graduate work with a 3.0 or higher GPA
- Six core required courses, including one field-based course (18 units)
- Four elective courses (12 units)
- Four one-unit workshops (4 units)
- Internship Seminar, In-Organization Experience, and Internship Reflection Seminar (2 unit required course)
- Capstone Proposal and Project (3 unit required course) must be at a "B" or better performance
- No more than 6 units of coursework may be completed outside of the Kroc School (of which only 3 units may be at the 300 or 400 level)
