












#### ITS - 2014 "Mobile First" Initiative



Eden Dahlstrom and Stephen diFilipo, *The Consumerization of Technology and the Bring-Your-Own-Everything (BYOE) Era of Higher Education*, ECAR Research Report (March 2013).

- Greater than 3 mobile devices per student
- 80% of College Millennials own a Smart Phone (never plug into network)
- USD's Next Generation Wi-Fi \$4.25
   Million campus overlay 802.11ac
- Campus-wide Cellular Distributed Antenna System (Verizon & AT&T)
- Continual augmentation of USD Internet Bandwidth
- Phase out of Cable TV
- iPad Mobility in the classroom
- All websites have responsive designs
- All applications development will focus on Mobile First.
- Rollout many more mobile services and applications: event check-in, gaming and gaminfication, geospatial tracking, etc.






