LRC Catalog

- The Legal Research Center's online catalog links to materials held at the LRC and the Main Library (Copley)
- The catalog can be used to find not just materials in our print collection, but also to access e-books and electronic databases

Lexis and Westlaw

Westlaw

- Westlaw has a few treatises helpful for international trade and trade agreements:
 - NAFTA Handbook
 - NAFTA: Legal Text & Interpretive Materials
 - Law and Practice of United States Regulation of International Trade (NAFTA, TPP)

Westlaw

- To access materials for Mexico, Canada, or any other foreign jurisdiction, start on the Westlaw main page and click on International Materials on the bottom right.
- Then select one of the main six foreign jurisdictions (Australia, Canada, European Union, Hong Kong, Korea, United Kingdom), or select Other International Jurisdictions.
- Both LexisNexis and Westlaw contain legal databases for a variety of countries. You will notice that coverage and currency varies by Country.

Lexis (use Lexis.com)

- INTERNATIONAL TRADE tab
 - Text and Supplemental Agreements - The complete NAFTA text with Annexes and Supplemental Agreements can be found at INTLAW: NAFTA.
 - Binational Panel decisions - LEXIS has a collection of panel decisions as well but it is not as complete as WESTLAW. It only contains decisions from April 1995.
