How do I find allowable tax deductions from 2014?

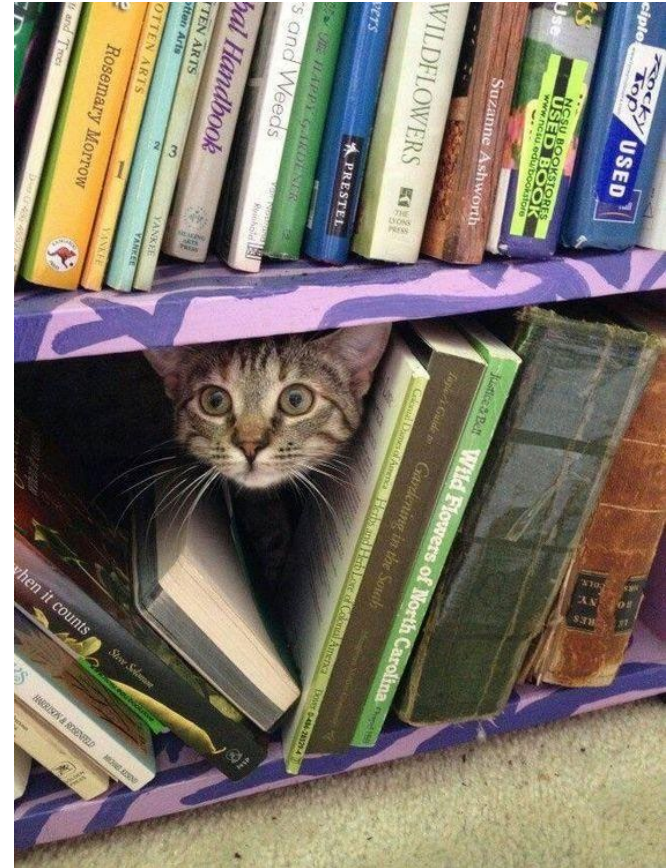
How can I find cases related to prosecutorial discretion in immigration cases?
