



### Annotated Text of CISG Article 96













A Contracting State whose legislation requires contracts of sale to be concluded in or evidenced by writing may at any time make a declaration in accordance with article 12 that any provision of article 11, article 29, or Part II of this Convention, that allows a contract of sale or its modification or termination by agreement or any offer, acceptance, or other indication of intention to be made in any form other than in writing, does not apply where any party has his place of business in that State.




 After clicking on Research Databases, click on the letter "K" for Kluwer Arbitration




- Now click on the linked title of the database "Kluwer Arbitration."


