### California's 'Restitution First Act' Puts Victim Restitution Ahead of Other Criminal Fines and Fees

Being convicted of a crime can get expensive. The California Constitution guarantees that any victim of a crime who has suffered economic loss as a result of that crime is entitled to restitution from the defendant upon conviction. (Cal. Const., art. I, § 28(b)(13); Pen. Code, § 1202.4(a); Welf. & Inst. Code, § 730.6(a)(1)). In addition to restitution owed to the victim or victims for any damage or harm caused, the law is full of various penalties, fines and assessments to compensate the state, courts and other entities involved in the administration of justice. Each county superior court typically has an established fee structure and collections unit (or works with an outside collections agency) to recover fines and fees.

## 1 Strategic Overview

California Summary Judgment

### §1.6 E. When Summary Judgment Is Appropriate

Motions for summary judgment or summary adjudication are appropriate when

- The dispositive issue in the case is one of law, not of fact;

**EXAMPLE ►** Examples of legally dispositive issues include the court's subject matter jurisdiction (*Garofalo v Princess Cruises, Inc.* (2000) 85 CA4th 1060, 1068); statutory interpretation, including preemptive effect (*Garofalo v Princess Cruises, Inc., supra*); application of statute to undisputed facts (*Schachter v Citigroup, Inc.* (2009) 47 C4th 610); contract interpretation (*C. L. Smith Co. v Roger Ducharme, Inc.* (1977) 65 CA3d 735, 743); and existence of a duty (see, e.g., *Denton v City of Fullerton* (1991) 233 CA3d 1636, 1639).

- The admissible evidence reveals no issue of material fact as to the matters for which the party has the burden of proof;
- There is no admissible evidence to prove any material fact as to which the other side has the burden of proof;
- No reasonable jury would accept the adversary's position on a fact issue that is a necessary element of the adversary's claim or defense;
- There is no material fact issue as to an important cause of action, defense, or issue of duty, and the elimination of that issue would significantly improve the posture of the case at trial; or
- No reasonable jury could find clear and convincing evidence of malice, fraud, or oppression, or approval/ratification by a principal against whom punitive damages are sought.

**NOTE ►** In federal court, a motion for summary judgment is also useful because the court can issue an order establishing certain facts in the action, even if it denies the motion. Fed R Civ P 56(g). *Code of Civil Procedure §437c* does not permit such an order in state court.

## §1.7 II. STRATEGIC CONSIDERATIONS

Most seasoned trial attorneys outline their anticipated opening or closing argument at the outset of a case, then prepare their case based on that outline. If there is any possibility of a summary judgment or summary adjudication motion, the attorney should also prepare an outline of the client's separate statement, either in favor of or in opposition to the anticipated motion. Doing so helps the attorney rigorously analyze whether to file a summary judgment or summary adjudication motion, creates a roadmap for the investigation, discovery, and legal research needed to make or oppose the motion, and helps the attorney evaluate the chances of failure and success of the motion, thus informing settlement strategy. On the moving party's separate statement, see §§6.21–6.35; on the opposing party's separate statement, see §§7.23–7.29.

The determination of whether to file a summary judgment or adjudication motion involves multiple strategic issues, including benefits and risks associated with such motions. See §§1.8–1.22.

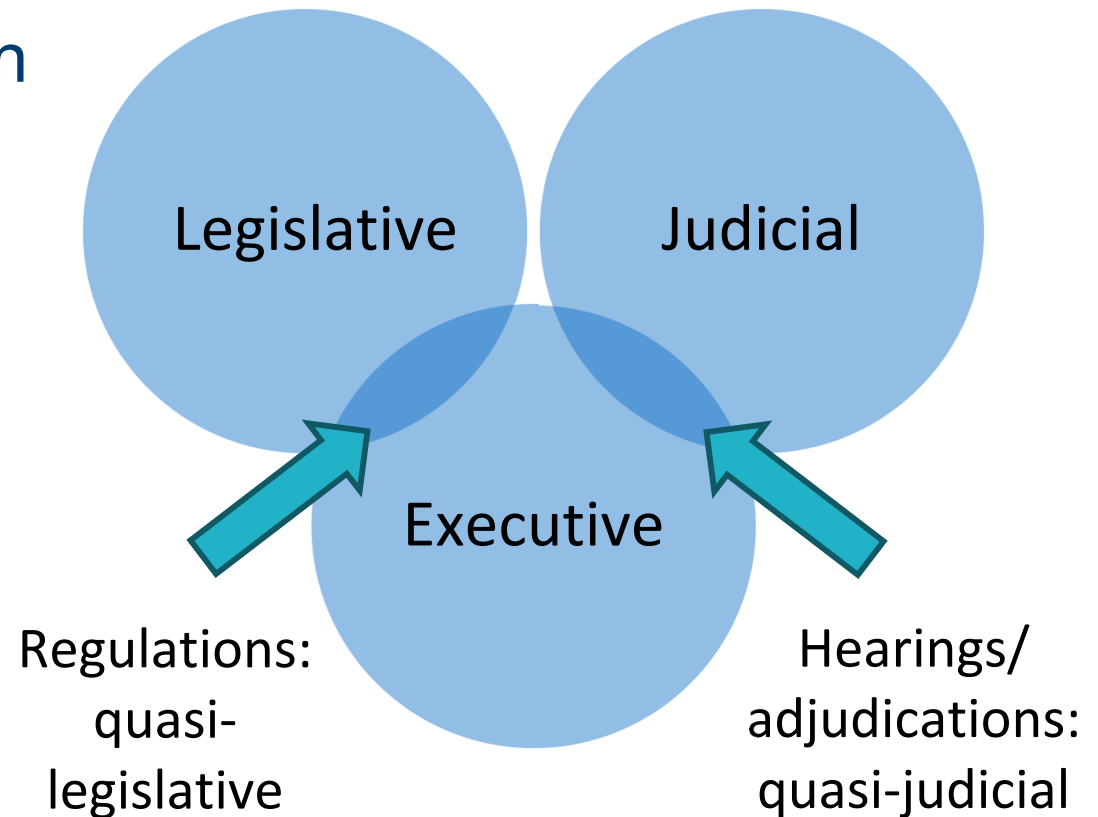

# Administrative Law

# Administrative Law: Overview

- Governs the creation and operation of administrative agencies
- Administrative law makes up a huge portion of “the law”



# Examples of Federal Agencies

- Department of Agriculture (USDA)
- US Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO)
- Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
- Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA)
- Federal Trade Commission (FTC)

# How Agencies are Created

- Legislature passes a law directing a government agency's purpose and "**enabling**" the agency to implement the law.
- To implement the law per the legislature's intent, the agency typically will have to:
  1. Promulgate **regulations** that provide more detailed rules and establish oversight processes
  2. Enforce the law through those processes, including administrative **hearings/adjudications**

# Promulgation of Regulations

Strict rules about what a federal agency must do (simplified):

1. Agency drafts and publishes proposed regulations in the [Federal Register](#) (Fed. Reg.)
2. Opportunity for public comment
3. Agency reviews comments, drafts and publishes final version in Fed. Reg.
4. Codify the final regulations in the [Code of Federal Regulations](#) (C.F.R.)

Published: 1936 –present

“[T]he official daily publication for rules, proposed rules, and notices of Federal agencies and organizations, as well as executive orders and other presidential documents.”

# Administrative Adjudications

Processes vary between agencies:

- Informal/formal
- Binding only on involved parties/carries precedence
- How and whether they are officially published

## Where to Look:

- Agency websites
- Westlaw (restricted summer access)
- Lexis, Bloomberg Law, specialty databases for selected agency adjudications
- HeinOnline (historical agency materials)

*....When in doubt, ask!*

# Administrative Guidance

- Some agencies put out informal documents that lay out current thinking on issues
  - Avoids strict requirements for promulgating regulations
  - Not legally binding, but can be a good indicator of an agency's position
  - May not be formally published—look on agency's website

# Dockets: The Basics

- A docket is a **record of all documents filed** by the parties or the court in any given case:
  - Searchable by **docket number** or **party name**
  - Also called **Register of Actions** in California courts
- ❖ Pleadings
  - ❖ Motions
  - ❖ Briefs
  - ❖ Exhibits
  - ❖ Orders
  - ❖ Judgments
  - ❖ Other various documents
